HOUSE BILL NO. 1527

AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 27-19-56.32, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS TO
 RECIPIENTS OF THE BRONZE STAR OR THE SILVER STAR; TO PRESCRIBE AN
 ADDITIONAL FEE FOR SUCH DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS; TO PROVIDE FOR
 THE DISTRIBUTION OF SUCH FEES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
 27-19-56.32, Mississippi Code of 1972:

9 27-19-56.32. In recognition of the patriotic services rendered by Mississippians who are recipients of the Bronze Star 10 or the Silver Star, any such person, upon complying with the motor 11 vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor 12 vehicles, and upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, 13 14 ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other 15 noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional 16 annual fee in the amount of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00), shall be 17 privileged to obtain one distinctive motor vehicle license plate 18 19 or tag for each motor vehicle registered in his name identifying him as a recipient of the Bronze Star or the Silver Star. 20

(2) The tags shall be of such color and design as the State
Tax Commission shall prescribe, subject to the approval of the
Mississippi License Tag Commission, and shall consist of such
letters or numbers or both as may be necessary to distinguish each
license tag.

(3) Application for the distinctive license tags shall be
made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State
Tax Commission. Applicants for such distinctive license tags

shall present to the issuing official written proof that the applicant is a recipient of the Bronze Star or Silver Star. The application and the additional fee, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.

36 (4) The distinctive license tag shall be issued for a
37 one-year period. The additional annual fee shall be due and
38 payable at the time of renewal registration.

39 (5) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the 40 State Treasury on the day received. At the end of each month, the 41 State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected under 42 this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute such 43 collections as follows:

(a) Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued under this section
shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of a
special fund to be administered by the board overseeing the
veterans nursing homes in this state for the benefit of indigent
veterans who are residents of such nursing homes.

50 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 51 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall 52 be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn 53 Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

54 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
55 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
56 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
57 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
58 reconstruction of highways.

(6) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the

The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) month and year license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which will expire the same month and year as the regular license tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 67 (7) tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 68 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 69 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 70 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 71 72 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 73 74 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 75 distinctive license tags issued under this section. 76

77 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from78 and after July 1, 2002.
