HOUSE BILL NO. 1565

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-3-519, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO PROHIBIT MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS IN MUNICIPALITIES
- HAVING A POPULATION OF 2,000 OR MORE FROM USING RADAR SPEED
- 4 DETECTION EQUIPMENT ON FEDERAL OR STATE HIGHWAYS; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-3-519, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 63-3-519. It is unlawful for any person or peace officer or
- 10 law enforcement agency, except the Mississippi Highway Safety
- 11 Patrol, to purchase or use or allow to be used any type of radar
- 12 speed detection equipment upon any public street, road or highway
- 13 of this state. However, such equipment may be used:
- 14 (a) By municipal law enforcement officers within a
- 15 municipality having a population of two thousand (2,000) or more
- 16 upon the public streets of the municipality, excluding federally
- 17 designated highways or highways on the state designated highway
- 18 system; and
- 19 (b) By any college or university campus police force
- 20 within the confines of any campus wherein more than two thousand
- 21 (2,000) students are enrolled.

- 23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2002.
