HOUSE BILL NO. 1569

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9-3-45, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW ANY OFFICIAL WHO IS DESIGNATED TO RECEIVE COPIES OF THE MISSISSIPPI SUPREME COURT CASES FROM THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO 3 DECLINE RECEIPT OF THE COPIES; TO AMEND SECTIONS 7-3-13 AND 7-3-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO MAKE TECHNICAL CHANGES IN 4 5 STATUTES PROVIDING FOR DISTRIBUTION OF THE SOUTHERN 6 7 REPORTER-MISSISSIPPI CASES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 9-3-45, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9 10 amended as follows: 9-3-45. It shall be the duty of the Secretary of State to 11 contract for the purchase of and to purchase not more than four 12 hundred (400) copies of the official Mississippi edition of the 13 decisions of the Supreme Court and advance sheets with headnotes. 14 15 The Supreme Court shall, when approved by the Chief Justice, certify the account therefor to the State Fiscal Officer, who 16 thereupon shall issue his warrant upon the State Treasury for the 17 amounts so specified. Of these copies, the Secretary of State 18 shall deliver, if so requested, a copy to each circuit judge, each 19 chancellor, each district attorney, and each county attorney, each 20 county judge, each Supreme Court judge, the Attorney General and 21 each assistant, and to all others heretofore or hereafter 22 authorized by law to receive same. Before delivery of the copies, 23 the Secretary of State shall first have stamped thereon as 24 follows: "Property of the State of Mississippi for the use of the 25 Judicial District, " and his successors in office; and 26 he shall place an appropriately similar stamp on each copy 27

delivered to the other court officers mentioned in this section.

- The contractor shall have exclusive sale of all reports
- 30 published under this section, including the advance sheets with
- 31 headnotes, but the contract shall provide that the permanent
- 32 volumes of the Mississippi Reports shall not sell, within the
- 33 state, for a greater price than that approved by the Chief
- 34 Justice. The contractor shall mail directly to each circuit
- 35 judge, each chancellor, each district attorney, and each county
- 36 attorney the advance sheets at the same time they are mailed out
- 37 to other subscribers within the state.
- 38 SECTION 2. Section 7-3-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 39 amended as follows:
- 40 7-3-13. The Secretary of State shall cause ten (10) copies
- 41 of each volume of the "Southern Reporter-Mississippi Cases" and
- 42 ten (10) copies of the department reports * * * to be provided to
- 43 the State Library.
- SECTION 3. Section 7-3-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 45 amended as follows:
- 46 7-3-15. The Secretary of State shall transmit, free of cost,
- 47 one (1) copy of each volume of "Southern Reporter-Mississippi
- 48 Cases" to the sheriff of each county of the state, for the county
- 49 library; one (1) copy of each volume thereof to each of the
- 50 following educational institutions * * *: Mississippi State
- 51 University, Alcorn State University, Mississippi University for
- 52 Women, Mississippi College School of Law, Delta State University,
- 53 Jackson State University, Mississippi Valley State University, and
- 54 the University of Southern Mississippi; ten (10) copies of each
- 55 volume thereof to the University of Mississippi; and one (1) copy
- of each volume to the Library of Congress at Washington, D.C.
- 57 The above provisions of this section are made in recognition
- 58 of benefits received through receipt at depository libraries and
- 59 elsewhere in the State of Mississippi of public documents of the
- 60 United States under the provisions of federal $\underline{\text{and state}}$ laws.



- 61 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 62 and after July 1, 2002.
