## HOUSE BILL NO. 1583

- AN ACT TO DEFINE AND CREATE THE OFFENSE OF SEXUAL MISCONDUCT; 1 2.
- TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 SECTION 1. (1) No person shall commit sexual misconduct
- upon any other person. "Sexual misconduct" means the intentional 5
- touching or feeling of the body or private parts of any person in 6
- a lewd and lascivious manner and without the consent of that 7
- 8 person.
- No person shall commit sexual misconduct upon a mentally 9
- defective, mentally incapacitated or physically helpless person, 10
- 11 with or without their consent.
- Intentional touching or feeling of the body or private 12
- parts shall include the direct, or indirect touching, fondling or 13
- manipulating of any part of the genital area, anus, groin, inner 14
- thighs, buttocks of a male or female and the female breast by any 15
- part of the body or by an object. 16
- (4) Upon conviction for sexual misconduct, the defendant 17
- shall be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than five (5) 18
- years in the State Penitentiary or a fine of not more than Five 19
- 20 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or both.
- Second and subsequent convictions will result in the 21
- offender registering as a sexual offender in the State of 22
- Mississippi. 23
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 24
- 25 and after July 1, 2002.
