## HOUSE BILL NO. 1594

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-35-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1
- MAKE CERTAIN TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO THE PROVISIONS OF LAW 2
- RELATING TO DISTRIBUTION OF FEES COLLECTED FROM THE ISSUANCE OF IDENTIFICATION CARDS ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; 3

- AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 45-35-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 8
- 45-35-7. (1) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this 9
- section, each applicant for an original identification card issued 10
- pursuant to this chapter who is entitled to issuance of such a 11
- card shall be issued a four-year card. Each card shall expire at 12
- midnight on the last day of the cardholder's birth month. 13
- 14 Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section,
- all renewal identification cards shall be for four-year periods 15
- and may be renewed any time during the birth month of the 16
- cardholder upon application and payment of the required fee. 17
- (3) Any applicant who is blind, as defined in Section 18
- 19 43-6-1, upon payment of the fee prescribed in this section, shall
- be issued an original identification card which shall remain valid 20
- for a period of ten (10) years. All renewal identification cards 21
- 22 issued to such persons shall also be valid for a period of ten
- (10) years. 23
- (4) A fee of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) shall be collected for 24
- the issuance of an original or renewal identification card plus 25
- the applicable photograph fee as provided in subsection (5) of 26
- 27 this section. The fee of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) shall be
- deposited into the State General Fund. The photograph fee shall 28

- 29 be deposited into a special photograph fee account or the State
- 30 General Fund as provided under subsection (5) of this section.
- 31 (5) The Commissioner of Public Safety, by rule or
- 32 regulation, shall establish an identification card photograph fee
- 33 which shall be the actual cost of the photograph rounded off to
- 34 the next highest dollar. Monies collected for the photograph fee
- 35 shall be deposited into a special photograph fee account which the
- 36 Department of Public Safety shall use to pay the actual cost of
- 37 producing the photographs. Any monies collected in excess of the
- 38 actual costs of the photography shall be deposited to the General
- 39 Fund of the State of Mississippi. \* \* \*
- 40 (6) Any person who, for medical reasons, surrenders his
- 41 unexpired driver's license, and any person whose unexpired
- 42 driver's license is suspended for medical reasons by the
- 43 Commissioner of Public Safety under Section 63-1-53(e), may be
- 44 issued an identification card without payment of a fee. The
- 45 identification card shall be valid for a period of four (4) years
- 46 from its date of issue. All renewals of such card shall be
- 47 subject to the fee $\underline{s}$  prescribed in subsection $\underline{s}$  (4) and (5) of this
- 48 section.
- 49 (7) The department shall maintain a record of all
- 50 identification cards issued, except for those cards cancelled,
- 51 surrendered or denied renewal.
- 52 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 53 and after its passage.
