- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 63-1-37 AND 45-35-9, MISSISSIPPI
- CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SECOND AND

- SUBSEQUENT DUPLICATE COPIES OF DRIVERS' LICENSES AND IDENTIFICATION CARDS ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; TO 4
- CLARIFY THE PROVISIONS OF LAW PROVIDING FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF 5
- FEES COLLECTED FROM THE ISSUANCE OF DRIVERS' LICENSES AND 6
- IDENTIFICATION CARDS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 7
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 63-1-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9
- 10 amended as follows:
- 63-1-37. In the event that a license or temporary driving 11
- permit issued under the provisions of this article is lost or 12
- destroyed, the licensee shall obtain from the commissioner a 13
- duplicate copy thereof and shall pay a fee in the amount of Three 14
- 15 Dollars (\$3.00) plus the applicable photograph fee for the first
- duplicate copy and a fee in the amount of Eight Dollars (\$8.00) 16
- plus the applicable photograph fee for the second and each 17
- subsequent duplicate copy. The license or permit shall be marked 18
- "Duplicate." 19
- All fees collected under this section, except photograph 20
- fees, shall be deposited into the State General Fund. Photograph 21
- fees collected under this section shall be deposited into a 22
- 23 special photograph fee account or into the State General Fund in
- 24 the same manner as photograph fees collected from the issuance of
- drivers' licenses under Section 63-1-43. 25
- SECTION 2. Section 45-35-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 26
- amended as follows: 27
- 28 45-35-9. (1) If an identification card issued under this
- chapter is lost, destroyed or mutilated, or a new name is 29

- 30 required, the person to whom it was issued may obtain a duplicate
- 31 by furnishing satisfactory proof of such fact to the department.
- 32 The same identifying data shall be furnished for a duplicate as
- 33 for an original card. A fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) plus the
- 34 applicable photograph fee shall be collected for the first
- 35 duplicate card issued * * * and a fee of Eight Dollars (\$8.00)
- 36 plus the applicable photograph fee shall be collected for the
- 37 second and each subsequent duplicate copy. However, whenever a
- 38 duplicate copy of an identification card is issued only because a
- 39 new name is required and the previously issued identification card
- 40 is returned to the department, the fee for the issuance of such
- 41 duplicate shall be Three Dollars (3.00) plus the applicable
- 42 photograph fee, regardless of whether the duplicate is the first,
- 43 second or subsequent duplicate copy. All fees collected under
- 44 this section, except photograph fees, shall be deposited into the
- 45 State General Fund. Photograph fees collected under this section
- 46 shall be deposited into a special photograph fee account or into
- 47 the State General Fund in the same manner as photograph fees
- 48 collected from the issuance of drivers' licenses under Section
- 49 63-1-43.
- 50 (2) Any person who loses an identification card and who,
- 51 after obtaining a duplicate, finds the original card shall
- 52 promptly surrender the original card to the department.
- 53 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 54 and after July 1, 2002.
