HOUSE BILL NO. 1605

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-13-133, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL EMPLOY A 2 3 PHYSICAL ACTIVITY COORDINATOR K-12; TO CODIFY NEW SECTION 37-13-134, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO SPECIFY THE MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS OF THE PHYSICAL ACTIVITY COORDINATOR; TO PROVIDE 4 5 THAT THE GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION ON PHYSICAL FITNESS AND SPORTS, THE 6 7 MISSISSIPPI COUNCIL ON OBESITY PREVENTION AND MANAGEMENT, THE TASK FORCE ON HEART DISEASE AND STROKE PREVENTION AND THE MISSISSIPPI 8 ALLIANCE FOR SCHOOL HEALTH SHALL PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE 9 STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION REGARDING THE EMPLOYMENT OF THE 10 PHYSICAL ACTIVITY COORDINATOR, AND THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSIDER 11 THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THOSE ENTITIES IN EMPLOYING THE PHYSICAL 12 ACTIVITY COORDINATOR; TO REQUIRE THE PHYSICAL ACTIVITY COORDINATOR 13 TO PRESENT A STATE PHYSICAL ACTIVITY PLAN EACH YEAR TO THOSE 14 ENTITIES; TO PROVIDE THAT BEGINNING WITH THE 2003-2004 SCHOOL 15 YEAR, EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL WITH ANY OF GRADES K-6 SHALL PROVIDE FOR 16 NOT LESS THAN THIRTY MINUTES OF QUALITY PHYSICAL ACTIVITY FOR THE 17 18 STUDENTS EACH SCHOOL DAY; TO PROVIDE THAT THE SCHOOLS SHALL COORDINATE THE PROVIDING OF THIS DAILY PHYSICAL ACTIVITY WITH THE 19 20 PHYSICAL ACTIVITY COORDINATOR, AND THE PHYSICAL ACTIVITY COORDINATOR SHALL PROMOTE AND SUPERVISE THE PROVIDING OF THIS 21 22 DAILY PHYSICAL ACTIVITY BY THE SCHOOLS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 37-13-133, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 24

25 amended as follows:

37-13-133. Under the provisions of Section 37-13-131, the 26 State Department of Education may provide for the services of a 27 School Health Services Coordinator, School Instruction 28 Coordinator, School Environmental Specialist, * * * and such other 29 professional and nonprofessional staff as may be needed and as 30 funds available to the department will permit. The State 31 32 Department of Education shall employ a Physical Activity Coordinator K-12 not later than September 1, 2002, in accordance 33 with the provisions of Section 37-13-134. It shall be the 34 35 responsibility of that professional staff to coordinate efforts of the personnel of the State Department of Education, the state's 36 colleges and universities, local public schools and other 37

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38 appropriate agencies to provide the comprehensive health education 39 curriculum.

40 **SECTION 2.** The following shall be codified as Section 41 37-13-134, Mississippi Code of 1972:

42 <u>37-13-134.</u> (1) The Physical Activity Coordinator employed 43 under Section 37-13-133 must have the qualifications prescribed in 44 any of the following paragraphs, which are listed in the order of 45 preference:

(a) A doctorate in physical education, exercise science
or a highly related field, and at least three (3) years of
experience in teaching physical education in grades K-12 or in
physical activity promotion/fitness leadership; or

50 (b) A master's degree in physical education, exercise 51 science or a highly related field, and at least five (5) years of 52 experience in teaching physical education in grades K-12 or in 53 physical activity promotion/fitness leadership; or

(c) A bachelor's degree in physical education, a
teacher's license, and at least seven (7) years of experience in
teaching physical education in grades K-12 or in physical activity
promotion/fitness leadership.

The Governor's Commission on Physical Fitness and Sports 58 (2) 59 created under Section 7-1-551 et seq., the Mississippi Council on Obesity Prevention and Management created under Section 41-101-1 60 et seq., the Task Force on Heart Disease and Stroke Prevention 61 62 created under Section 41-103-1 et seq., and the Mississippi Alliance for School Health shall provide recommendations to the 63 64 State Department of Education regarding the employment of the Physical Activity Coordinator. The department shall consider the 65 recommendations of those entities in employing the Physical 66 Activity Coordinator. 67

(3) The Physical Activity Coordinator shall present a state
physical activity plan each year to the Governor's Commission on
Physical Fitness and Sports, the Mississippi Council on Obesity
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Prevention and Management, the Task Force on Heart Disease and 71 Stroke Prevention, and the Mississippi Alliance for School Health. 72 SECTION 3. Beginning with the 2003-2004 school year, each 73 public school in the state with any of the grades K-6 shall 74 provide for not less than thirty (30) minutes of quality physical 75 activity for the students each school day. The schools shall 76 coordinate the providing of this daily physical activity with the 77 Physical Activity Coordinator of the State Department of 78 Education, and the Physical Activity Coordinator shall promote and 79 supervise the providing of this daily physical activity by the 80 81 schools. SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 82

and after July 1, 2002.

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
