- 2 TO AUTHORIZE MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS WITHIN THE
- 3 BOUNDARIES OF ANY INCORPORATED MUNICIPALITY IN WHICH IS LOCATED A
- 4 PUBLIC COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO USE RADAR SPEED DETECTION EQUIPMENT
- 5 UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE MUNICIPALITY; AND FOR RELATED
- 6 PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-3-519, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 63-3-519. (1) It is unlawful for any person or peace
- 11 officer or law enforcement agency, except the Mississippi Highway
- 12 Safety Patrol, to purchase or use or allow to be used any type of
- 13 radar speed detection equipment upon any public street, road or
- 14 highway of this state. However, such equipment may be used:
- 15 (a) By municipal law enforcement officers within the
- 16 boundaries of any incorporated municipality in which is located a
- 17 public community college upon the public streets of the
- 18 municipality;
- 19 (b) By municipal law enforcement officers within a
- 20 municipality having a population of two thousand (2,000) or more
- 21 upon the public streets of the municipality;
- 22 <u>(c)</u> By any college or university campus police force
- 23 within the confines of any campus wherein more than two thousand
- 24 (2,000) students are enrolled; and
- 25 <u>(d)</u> By municipal law enforcement officers in any
- 26 municipality having a population in excess of fifteen thousand
- 27 (15,000) according to the latest federal census on federally
- 28 designated highways lying within the corporate limits.

- 29 <u>(2)</u> The Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol <u>shall</u> not set up
- 30 radar on highways within municipalities with a population in
- 31 excess of fifteen thousand (15,000) according to the latest
- 32 federal census.
- 33 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 34 and after July 1, 2002.
