5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
7	99-19-18, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972:
8	99-19-18. When any person is convicted of a felony or
9	felonies in which public funds in the amount of Ten Thousand
10	Dollars (\$10,000.00) or more were unlawfully taken or obtained,

- 11 the sentence imposed by the court shall include a minimum term of
- 12 imprisonment of one (1) year in the custody of the Department of
- 13 Corrections. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, such
- 14 mandatory minimum term shall not be reduced or suspended nor shall
- 15 such person be eligible for probation or parole before the
- 16 expiration of one (1) year of incarceration.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2002.
