COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 1623

1	AN ACT TO REQUIRE PERSONS TRANSFERRING OWNERSHIP OF BERMUDA
2	GRASS TO BECOME CERTIFIED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF AGRICULTURE AND
3	COMMERCE; TO PROVIDE THAT NAMES OF GRASSES SHALL NOT INFRINGE ON A
4	NAME ALREADY ON THE MARKET; TO PROVIDE THAT THE COMMISSIONER OF
5	AGRICULTURE SHALL PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT
5	THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF
7	THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** (1) Every person, firm, association or
- 10 corporation that shall transfer ownership of Bermuda grass, or
- 11 that shall issue, use or circulate any certificate, advertisement,
- 12 tag, seal, poster, letterhead, marking circular, written or
- 13 printed representation or description of or pertaining to Bermuda
- 14 grass intended for sprigging or sale shall conform to the
- 15 certification standards or requirements as made by the
- 16 Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce. Such persons, firms,
- 17 associations and corporations, before transferring ownership of
- 18 Bermuda grass, on or before the first day of July of each year,
- 19 shall secure an annual certificate from the Commissioner of
- 20 Agriculture to engage in such business or practice. The
- 21 certificate fee shall not exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
- 22 each such person or place of business every year.
- 23 (2) If a person, firm, association or corporation discovers
- 24 a new type or variety of grass, such entity shall not name the
- 25 grass in such a manner as to infringe on a name already on the
- 26 market.
- 27 (3) The Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce shall
- 28 promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions of
- 29 this act.

- 30 (4) Upon compliance by the applicant with the requirements
- 31 of the Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce, the commissioner
- 32 shall issue a certificate of grass registration to the applicant.
- 33 Any certificate of grass registration issued by the commissioner
- 34 under the provisions hereof, or a copy duly certified by the
- 35 commissioner, shall be admissible in evidence as competent and
- 36 sufficient proof of the registration of such grass in any actions
- 37 or judicial proceedings in any court of this state.
- 38 (5) Any owner of a certificate of grass registration under
- 39 this act may proceed by suit to enjoin the manufacture, use,
- 40 transfer of ownership, display or sale of any counterfeits or
- 41 imitations thereof, and any court of competent jurisdiction may
- 42 grant injunctions to restrain such manufacture, use, transfer of
- 43 ownership, display or sale and may require the defendants to pay
- 44 to such owner all profits derived from or all damages suffered by
- 45 reason of such wrongful manufacture, use, transfer of ownership,
- 46 display or sale.
- 47 (6) Any person who knowingly, or as a result either of gross
- 48 negligence or of a failure to make a reasonable effort to inform
- 49 himself of the pertinent facts, violates any provision of this act
- or the rules and regulations made and promulgated thereunder shall
- 51 be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, is subject to pay
- 52 a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and not more
- 53 than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the first violation and
- 54 not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and not more than One
- 55 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each violation thereafter.
- 56 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 57 and after its passage.
