HOUSE BILL NO. 1670 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-26-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO PROVIDE THAT BOARD MEMBERS OF COMMUNITY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS 2 3 SHALL DESIGNATE ONE MEMBER TO ATTEND MANAGEMENT TRAINING; AND FOR 4 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 41-26-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 41-26-101. (1) The governing board of any community public 8 9 water system, of which the members are elected or reelected after June 30, 2001, shall designate one (1) member of the board who 10 shall attend a minimum of eight (8) hours of management training 11 within two (2) years following the designation of that board 12 member. Any board member failing to complete the management 13 training within two (2) years after his designation shall be 14 subject to removal from the board by the remaining members. If a 15 board member has undergone training and is reelected to the board, 16 that person shall not be required to attend training as provided 17 18 by this subsection. The management training shall be organized by the State 19 (2)Department of Health, in cooperation with the Mississippi Rural 20 Water Association and other organizations. The management 21 training shall include information on water system management and 22 financing, rate setting and structures, operations and 23 maintenance, applicable laws and regulations, ethics, the duties 24 and responsibilities of a board member and other information 25 26 deemed necessary by the department after consultation with the association and other organizations. fee not to exceed Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) per member to defray the actual costs of providing the materials and training. These costs shall be reimbursed to the board member as an expense of the community public water system.

(3) To avoid board members <u>and elected officials</u> having to interfere with their jobs or employment, management training sessions may be divided into segments and, to the greatest extent possible, shall be scheduled for evening sessions. The department shall conduct management training on a regional basis and shall use community college or other public facilities for the convenience of board members.

40 (4) The department may make exceptions to and grant
41 exemptions and variances to the requirements of this section for
42 good cause shown.

43 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 44 and after July 1, 2002.
