HOUSE BILL NO. 1681

- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HINDS COUNTY TO IMPOSE ADDITIONAL COURT COSTS IN CERTAIN CASES FOR THE PURPOSE
- 3 OF FUNDING A DRUG ABUSE RESISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAM OR SIMILAR
- 4 PROGRAM IN THE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of Hinds County,
- 7 Mississippi, in its discretion, by resolution duly adopted and
- 8 entered on its minutes, may require the imposition of the
- 9 following additional court costs in the justice, county and
- 10 circuit courts situated within the county:
- 11 (a) Upon each person convicted under the Mississippi
- 12 Implied Consent Law, the Controlled Substances Law or for
- 13 illegally selling or purchasing alcoholic beverages, light wine or
- 14 beer, the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00); and
- 15 (b) Upon each person convicted of any misdemeanor other
- 16 than those specified under paragraph (a) of this subsection, the
- 17 amount of Five Dollars (\$5.00).
- 18 (2) The resolution adopted by the board of supervisors shall
- 19 include a statement of the board's intent to impose the additional
- 20 court costs, the purpose therefor and the date on which the courts
- 21 will begin to impose the additional court costs.
- 22 (3) The avails of any additional court costs imposed under
- 23 subsection (1) of this section shall be used to fund the
- 24 implementation of a Drug Abuse Resistance Education Program or
- 25 similar program designed to deter the abuse of drugs in the county
- 26 school district and/or any separate school district that
- 27 encompasses territory within Hinds County and any adjoining county
- 28 or counties, as specified in the resolution. The board of

- 29 supervisors shall determine, in its discretion, if it will
- 30 contribute funds and the amount thereof, if any, for such a
- 31 program in a separate school district that encompasses territory
- 32 within an adjoining county or counties.
- 33 (4) Upon the adoption of the resolution stating its intent
- 34 to impose the additional court costs, the board of supervisors
- 35 shall provide for the creation of a special county fund in which
- 36 all court costs collected under subsection (1) of this section
- 37 shall be deposited. Monies in the special fund shall be used for
- 38 the sole purpose of defraying the costs of the Drug Abuse
- 39 Resistance Education Program or similar program.
- 40 (5) The clerks of the respective courts shall deposit and
- 41 account for the additional court costs collected under subsection
- 42 (1) of this section in the same manner as fines collected in those
- 43 courts.
- 44 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 45 and after its passage.
