HOUSE BILL NO. 1684

1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 899, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1988, 2 AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 857, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1992, AS 3 AMENDED BY CHAPTER 904, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2000, TO 4 INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF THE MINIMUM MONTHLY BENEFITS AUTHORIZED FOR 5 PERSONS RECEIVING BENEFITS UNDER THE DISABILITY AND RELIEF FUND 6 FOR FIREMEN AND POLICEMEN OF THE CITY OF VICKSBURG; AND FOR 7 RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. Chapter 899, Local and Private Laws of 1988, as 10 amended by Chapter 857, Local and Private Laws of 1992, is amended 11 as follows:

Section 1. The governing authorities of the City of 12 Vicksburg, Mississippi, may, in their discretion, * * * 13 appropriate and transfer annually from the general fund of the 14 15 city to the Disability and Relief Fund for Firemen and Policemen of the city sufficient additional funds to provide for the payment 16 17 of minimum monthly benefits of not less than Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) per month to all persons now or hereafter 18 entitled to receive benefits under any provision of Section 19 21-29-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, by virtue of service 20 as a member of the fire and/or police department of the City of 21 Vicksburg. When the governing authorities of the City of 22 23 Vicksburg, by resolution duly adopted and entered on their minutes, have transferred sufficient additional funds to fund such 24 minimum monthly benefits, as determined by the Board of Trustees 25 of the Public Employees' Retirement System of Mississippi, then 26 the board of trustees shall pay such minimum monthly payments to 27 28 the persons authorized and entitled to receive such benefits.
