HOUSE BILL NO. 1718

AN ACT MAKING A REAPPROPRIATION OF STATE GENERAL FUNDS TO THE 1 STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF 2 THE MINIMUM EDUCATION PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 5 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the State General 6 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Department of 7 Education for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of 8

- state general funds, as authorized in House Bill No. 1611, 2001 9 Regular Session, for the support and maintenance of the Minimum 10
- Education Program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and
- ending June 30, 2003......\$11,188,245.00. 12
- 13 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the
- provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 14
- exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2002. 15
- SECTION 2. This reappropriation is made for the purpose of 16
- authorizing the expenditure of state general funds appropriated in 17
- fiscal year 2002 for the support and maintenance of the Minimum 18
- Education Program that would lapse into the State General Fund at 19
- the end of fiscal year 2002, to fund the Mississippi Adequate 20
- 21 Education Program during fiscal year 2003. The Legislature
- recognizes that the funds reappropriated under the provisions of 22
- Section 1 are contingent upon no budget cuts being made by the 23
- Governor to the fiscal year 2002 appropriation made in House Bill 24
- No. 1611 for the support and maintenance of the Minimum Education 25
- 26 Program. It is the intention of the Legislature that, if it is
- 27 necessary for the Governor to make cuts to the fiscal year 2002

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- 28 appropriation made in House Bill No. 1611 for the support and
- 29 maintenance of the Minimum Education Program, that the amount
- 30 being reappropriated in this act not be subject to any reduction
- 31 in fiscal year 2002.
- 32 **SECTION 3.** The money reappropriated by this act shall be
- 33 paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury
- 34 to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this
- 35 act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the
- 36 State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions
- 37 signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner
- 38 provided by law.
- 39 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 40 and after July 1, 2002.
