HOUSE BILL NO. 1746

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF 1 SMITHVILLE, MISSISSIPPI, TO EXTEND THE POLICE JURISDICTION OF THE 2 TOWN OF SMITHVILLE OUTSIDE OF THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE 3 MUNICIPALITY TO INCLUDE THE CAMPUS, PARKING LOTS AND BALL FIELDS 4 OF THE SMITHVILLE SCHOOL; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. (1) The governing authorities of the Town of Smithville, Mississippi, in their discretion, may extend the 8 9 police jurisdiction of the Town of Smithville to an area one thousand (1,000) feet west, one thousand (1,000) feet north and 10 one thousand (1,000) feet east on each side of the real property 11 of the Smithville school campus, parking lots and ball fields in 12 Monroe County, being partly within and partly outside of the Town 13 14 of Smithville, the Smithville school land lying and being north of the centerline of the Smithville-Tremont Road within and outside 15 of the corporate boundaries of the Town of Smithville, and to the 16 west of a north/south line running perpendicular to the 17 intersection of the Smithville-Tremont Road and the 18 Smithville-Fulton Road in the Town of Smithville. 19 Any police jurisdiction that the Town of Smithville may 20 (2) be granted under this act shall be concurrent with the 21 22 jurisdiction of Monroe County. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23 and after its passage. 24
