HOUSE BILL NO. 1765

AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 1 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE BOARD OF 2 3 COSMETOLOGY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2003. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Cosmetology, for the 7 purpose of defraying the expenses of the board for the fiscal year 8 beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... 9\$ 692,841.00. 10 SECTION 2. Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 36 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 39 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 41 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 42 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 43 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 44 45 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 46 47 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 48 49 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 50 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 51 52 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 53 54 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 55 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 56 57 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 58 59 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 60

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61 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. If not needed for other purposes, the State 67 Treasurer shall invest any part of or all monies herein approved 68 and any surplus funds of the State Board of Cosmetology for a 69 period of ninety (90) days or more at the highest rate of interest 70 71 obtainable and credit such to this respective fund. Monies shall be invested by the Treasurer in any short-term bonds, notes or 72 other direct obligations of the United States of America or the 73 State of Mississippi or any county or municipality of this state, 74 75 which county or municipal bonds have been approved by a reputable bond attorney or have been validated by a decree of the court, or 76 in savings accounts or certificates of deposit of a state or 77 78 national bank in the State of Mississippi, or in federally insured savings and loan associations in the State of Mississippi; and in 79 80 any event, the bonds, notes or obligations in which such funds are invested shall mature or be redeemable prior to the time the funds 81 82 so invested will be needed for the purposes herein provided.

83 **SECTION 4.** It is the intent of this legislation to provide 84 the funds for the board to meet when necessary, but under no 85 circumstances shall it meet more than sixty-two (62) days a year.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
