5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Nursing
9	Home Administrators for the purpose of defraying the expenses of
LO	the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending
L1	June 30, 2003\$ 134,702.00.
L2	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
L3	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

L9	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
20	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
21	equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the
22	Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00),
23	whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.
24	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
25	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
26	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
27	Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003
28	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or
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- pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 29 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 30 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 31 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 32 33 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 34 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 35 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 36 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 37 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 38 39 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 40 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 41 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 42 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 43 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 44 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 45 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 46 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 47 48 the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 55 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
  56 Mississippi State Board of Nursing Home Administrators deposit all
  57 revenue generated into a special fund in the State Treasury to the
  58 credit of the Mississippi State Board of Nursing Home
  59 Administrators and that all interest earned or deposited to the
- 60 fund shall remain in the fund and not be paid into the State
- 61 General Fund of Mississippi.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002.

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
