4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:			
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be			
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State			
7	Treasury to the credit of the Public Service Commission Regulation			
8	Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi			
9	Public Service Commission for the fiscal year beginning			
10	July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003			
11	\$ 7,818,719.00.			
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of			
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be			
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

- 68 SECTION 3. None of the funds herein appropriated by this act
- 69 to the Public Service Commission shall be expended for any purpose
- 70 that is not actually required or necessary for performing any of
- 71 the powers or duties of the Mississippi Public Service Commission
- 72 that are authorized by the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, state
- 73 or federal law, or rules or regulations that implement state or
- 74 federal law.
- 75 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 76 Public Service Commission shall have the authority to escalate and
- 77 expend funds from any proceeds arising from participation in drug
- 78 seizure activities not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 79 (\$50,000.00), in accordance with the rules and regulations of the
- 80 Department of Finance and Administration.
- 81 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that with
- 82 the funds provided herein, overtime may be paid to PSC-Enforcement
- 83 Office Regulated Carrier positions, the PSC-Enforcement Officer
- 84 Chief position, PSC-Enforcement Officer District Supervisor
- 85 positions, PSC-Special Projects Officer IV position, and
- 86 PSC-Training Director position.
- 87 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 88 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 89 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 90 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 91 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 92 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

93 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 94 and after July 1, 2002.
