Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 37 38 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 39 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 41 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 42 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 43 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 44 45 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002, data, for the period of July 1, 2002, through December 31, 2002, and 46 47 January 1, 2003, through June 30, 2003, that project the annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 48 49 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 50 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 51 52 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semiannual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 53 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 54 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 55 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 56 57 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 58 59 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement

62 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 63 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

68 SECTION 3. None of the funds herein appropriated by this act 69 to the Public Service Commission shall be expended for any purpose 70 that is not actually required or necessary for performing any of 71 the powers or duties of the Mississippi Public Service Commission 72 that are authorized by the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, state 73 or federal law, or rules or regulations that implement state or 74 federal law.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Public Service Commission shall have the authority to escalate and expend funds from any proceeds arising from participation in drug seizure activities not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00), in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration.

81 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that with 82 the funds provided herein, overtime may be paid to PSC-Enforcement 83 Office Regulated Carrier positions, the PSC-Enforcement Officer 84 Chief position, PSC-Enforcement Officer District Supervisor 85 positions, PSC-Special Projects Officer IV position, and 86 PSC-Training Director position.

87 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 88 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 89 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 90 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 91 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 92 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
