HOUSE BILL NO. 1782

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 2 MISSISSIPPI REAL ESTATE COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2003. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 Treasury to the credit of the Real Estate License Fund, for the 7 purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Real Estate 8 Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending 9 June 30, 2003.....\$ 827,859.00. 10 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 11 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be 12 13 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of expenditure: 14 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 15 Personal Services: 16 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 17 490,707.00 Travel and Subsistence..... 18 33,250.00 Contractual Services..... 19 263,502.00 Commodities..... 31,900.00 20 21 Capital Outlay: 22 Other Than Equipment..... 0.00 3,500.00 23 Equipment..... Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 36 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 39 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 41 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 42 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 43 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 44 45 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 46 47 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 48 49 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 50 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 51 52 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 53 54 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 55 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 56 57 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 58 59 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 60

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61 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 67 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 68 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 69 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 70 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 71 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 72 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 73 74 and after July 1, 2002.
