AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION 2 3 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2003. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Soil and 7 8 Water Conservation Commission for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses of the commission and carrying out the 9 provisions of Section 69-27-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, 10 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending 11 12 June 30, 2003..... \$ 726,923.00. 13 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 14 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Soil and 15 Water Conservation Commission which is comprised of special source 16 funds collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for 17 18 the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... 19 \$ 1,392,663.00. 20 21 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below 22 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 23 expenditure: 24 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 25 26 Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 27 713,572.00

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cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 61 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 62 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 63 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 64 65 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 66 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 67 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 68 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 69 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 70 71 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 72 73 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 74

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance withthe terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

81 SECTION 4. The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission 82 is hereby authorized to retain all funds generated from the sale 83 of equipment. Any funds made available from the sale of equipment 84 shall be deposited into the special fund in the State Treasury to 85 the credit of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission and shall 86 be used solely for the purpose of purchasing equipment.

87 SECTION 5. The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission 88 is hereby authorized to receive, budget and expend any proceeds 89 derived from the sale of bonds authorized in Section 69-27-331 et 90 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. All expenditures shall be in 91 accordance with conditions provided in Section 69-27-331 et seq., 92 Mississippi Code of 1972.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 94 Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall have the authority to 95 escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed 96 Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) in accordance 97 with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 98 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 99 federal funds.

100 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the intention of the Legislature that Sixty-five Thousand Dollars 101 (\$65,000.00) be used for the purpose of funding a Beaver Control 102 103 Cost Share program. The Mississippi Soil and Water Conservation 104 Commission shall promulgate rules and regulations for the 105 establishment and operation of the program on a fund matching 106 basis with the county unit of government. Funds not expended or encumbered in a county may be transferred to another county during 107 the fiscal year. Only those funds specifically appropriated for 108 the Beaver Control Cost Share program shall be used in any such 109 110 program.

SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 111 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 112 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 113 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 114 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 115 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 116 117 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002. 118
