1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2003; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending
10	June 30, 2003\$ 5,860,619.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of
14	Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds
15	collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the
16	purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal
17	year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003
18	\$ 2,387,396.00.
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
21	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

48	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of

64 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any

65 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the

agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed

67 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal

68 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with

69 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce

70 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement

71 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as

72 the requirements of this provision are met.

73 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

75 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

76 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this

act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

79 **SECTION 4.** The Mississippi Department of Archives and

80 History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant,

81 donation or contribution from any individual, public or private

82 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the

83 operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or

84 contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and

regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a

86 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

87 **SECTION 5.** It is the intent of the Legislature that the

88 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the

89 maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with

90 the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these

91 charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the

92 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of

93 Archives and History.

98	SECTION 7. In addition to all other sums herein

SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 129 130 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 131 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 132 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 133 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 134 Legislature. It shall be the responsibility of the 141 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 142 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 143 144 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 145 146 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 147 148 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 149 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 150 151 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 152 153 the requirements of this provision are met. SECTION 8. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Six Hundred 154 Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) is provided to the Department of 155 156 Archives and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help 157 158 support the preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00),

SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002.

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
