| 5 | SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 6 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State |
| 7 | General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of |
| 8 | defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Arts Commission for the |
| 9 | fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003 |
| 10 | \$ 1,332,747.00. |
| 11 | SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 12 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special |
| 13 | fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Arts |
| 14 | Commission which is comprised of special source funds and |
| 15 | donations collected by or otherwise available to the commission, |
| 16 | for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for |
| 17 | the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003. |

| 19 | SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of |
| 20 | Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below |

- agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 61 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 62 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 63 64 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 65 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 66 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 67 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 68 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 69 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 70 71 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 72 73 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law. 74
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, funds in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31,

- 87 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 88 Arts Commission shall have the authority to transfer dollars
- 89 appropriated in the major object of expenditure "Subsidies, Loans
- 90 and Grants," designated for the "Challenge Program," specific
- 91 amounts to a special fund in the State Treasury called the Arts
- 92 Commission Challenge Initiative Fund. The unexpended amounts
- 93 remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse

94 $\,$ into the State General Fund and may be expended by the commission

95 in subsequent fiscal years upon appropriation of the Legislature.

- 96 Any interest earned on the fund shall be deposited to the credit
- 97 of the fund and may be disbursed by the commission upon
- 98 appropriations of the Legislature. It is the intention of the
- 99 Legislature that the commission may award grants to arts
- 100 organizations from monies in the fund and the grantees will be
- 101 required to provide matching funds for the grants in an amount of
- 102 not less than two (2) times the amount of the grant.
- 103 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 104 Mississippi Arts Commission shall have the authority to escalate
- 105 its budget and expend funds from any source available not to
- 106 exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), that may become
- 107 available to the Commission in accordance with the rules and
- 108 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a
- 109 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- 110 **SECTION 7.** In addition to all other sums heretofore
- 111 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 112 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 113 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi Arts
- 114 Commission for the support of the Glory of Dresden Exhibition, for
- 115 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003
- 116\$ 1,000,000.00.
- It is the intention of the Legislature that after all debts
- 118 for the Glory of Dresden Exhibition have been paid, any excess
- 119 state funds shall be returned to the State of Mississippi.
- 120 **SECTION 8.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 121 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 122 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 123 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 124 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 125 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002.
