11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
12	SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
14	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying
15	salaries, mileage, insurance, matching funds and the daily expense
16	allowance of the members of the Legislature for the Regular
17	Session of 2002 and providing contingent funds for the House of
18	Representatives and Senate for the fiscal year beginning
19	July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003, as follows:

83	SECTION 4. The Legislature shall have the authority to
84	escalate its budget and expend funds from the Legislative
85	Extraordinary Session Expense Revolving Fund not to exceed the
86	amount stated in Section 5-1-57, Mississippi Code of 1972, in
87	accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance
88	and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
89	federal funds. Those funds shall be used only to pay the expenses
90	of the members of the Legislature incurred during any
91	Extraordinary Session of the Legislature occurring during the
92	period beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003.
93	SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
94	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
95	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
96	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

- 97 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 98 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 99 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 100 and after July 1, 2002, with the exception of Section 4 which
