## HOUSE BILL NO. 1803

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI ADEQUATE EDUCATION PROGRAM FOR THE 3 FISCAL YEAR 2003.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Department of Education for defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Adequate Education Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... \$ 1,369,417,114.00.

SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 12 13 Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Education which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise 14 available to the department, for the purpose of defraying the 15 expenses of the Mississippi Adequate Education Program for the 16 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... 17 \$ 18 194,971,701.00.

SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 19 20 following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby 21 appropriated out of any money in the Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 22 1972, not otherwise appropriated, to the State Department of 23 Education, for the purpose of providing funding for the 24 Mississippi Adequate Education Program for the fiscal year 25 26 beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... .....\$ 27 94,971,701.00.

Of the funds provided herein for the purpose of 56 funding the Mississippi Adequate Education Program as determined 57 under Section 37-151-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, the base student 58 59 cost in Fiscal Year 2003 shall be Three Thousand Four Hundred Twenty Seven Dollars (\$3,427.00). 60 H. 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61 **SECTION 6.** Of the funds appropriated herein, an amount not 62 more than Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00) shall be derived 63 from the Interim School District Capital Expenditure Fund for the 64 benefit of the school districts as authorized in Mississippi 65 Annotated, Section 37-151-7 (5).

66 **SECTION 7.** Of the funds appropriated herein, it is the 67 intention of the Legislature that Twenty Million Dollars 68 (\$20,000,000.00) from the Public School Building Fund shall be 69 used for the Mississippi Adequate Education Program.

SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 70 71 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 72 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 73 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 74 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 75 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 76 and after July 1, 2002. 77
