HOUSE BILL NO. 1824

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO THOMAS JAMES
2 FAIRLEY OF HARRISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Thomas James Fairley of Harrison County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction of grand larceny in Harrison County, Mississippi, in
8 1976, and who has completed the penalty and any conditions imposed
9 upon him for such conviction. The Legislature has been reliably
10 informed that he is now conducting himself as a law-abiding and
11 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
13 and after its passage.
