HOUSE BILL NO. 1839

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS TO GRANT PARTIAL AD 1 VALOREM TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR COMMERCIAL POULTRY HOUSES; TO PROVIDE 2 FOR THE MAXIMUM LENGTH OF TIME AND MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF EXEMPTIONS 3

GRANTED UNDER THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

(1) In order to provide incentives to support

the continued development and expansion of the commercial poultry 7

processing industry and the numerous jobs and other economic 8

9 development benefits such industry has provided to the economy of

the State of Mississippi, the board of supervisors of any county 10

may provide partial ad valorem tax exemptions for commercial 11

poultry houses in the manner provided in this section. 12

(2) (a) For any commercial poultry house constructed after 13

January 1, 2002, the board of supervisors of any county may exempt 14

a portion of the assessed value of such poultry house in the 15

manner provided in this subsection (2). The amount of such 16

exemption shall not exceed one-third (1/3) of the assessed value 17

of the commercial poultry house for the year for which an 18

exemption is granted, and the time for the exemption shall be for 19

a period not to exceed three (3) years which shall begin to run on 20

the date of completion of the commercial poultry house. The date 21

of completion of a commercial poultry house shall be the date on 22

which operations of the poultry house begin. 23

Any request for an exemption under this subsection 24

(2) must be made in writing on an application form prescribed by 25

the board of supervisors providing full information about the 26

property for which the exemption is requested. The granting of 27

- 28 each individual exemption under this subsection (2) shall be
- 29 recorded in the official minutes of the board of supervisors.
- 30 (c) Any exemption granted under this subsection (2)
- 31 shall be in addition to all other exemptions heretofore granted by
- 32 the laws of the State of Mississippi.
- 33 (3) (a) For any commercial poultry house constructed before
- 34 January 1, 2002, the board of supervisors of any county may exempt
- 35 a portion of the assessed value of any such poultry house in the
- 36 manner provided in this subsection (3). The amount of such
- 37 exemption shall not exceed one-third (1/3) of the assessed value
- 38 of the commercial poultry house for the year for which an
- 39 exemption is granted. The time for such exemption shall be as
- 40 follows: (i) the exemption may be for a period of one (1) year
- 41 for a commercial poultry house that has been in operation at least
- 42 three (3) years; (ii) the exemption may be for a period not to
- 43 exceed two (2) years for a commercial poultry house that has been
- 44 in operation at least one (1) year but less than three (3) years;
- 45 and (iii) the exemption may be for a period not to exceed three
- 46 (3) years for a commercial poultry house that has been in
- 47 operation less than one (1) year.
- 48 (b) Any request for an exemption under this subsection
- 49 (3) must be made in writing on an application form prescribed by
- 50 the board of supervisors providing full information about the
- 51 property for which the exemption is requested. The granting of
- 52 each individual exemption under this subsection (3) shall be
- 53 recorded in the official minutes of the board of supervisors.
- 54 (c) Any exemption granted under this subsection (3)
- shall be in addition to all other exemptions heretofore granted by
- 56 the laws of the State of Mississippi.
- 57 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 58 and after its passage.
