## HOUSE BILL NO. 1859

- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF 1 LEAKESVILLE, MISSISSIPPI, TO OPERATE ITS WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM WITHIN A CERTAIN DISTANCE OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN 2 3 4 OF LEAKESVILLE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any provisions of Section 6
- 21-27-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, to the contrary, the governing 7
- authorities of the Town of Leakesville in Greene County, 8
- 9 Mississippi, in their discretion, may construct, expand, operate
- and maintain the water distribution system of the Town of 10
- Leakesville for a distance not to exceed fifteen (15) miles from 11
- the corporate limits of the Town of Leakesville. Whenever such 12
- service is furnished to any consumer residing outside the 13
- corporate limits of the Town of Leakesville, the consumer may not 14
- be charged at a rate greater than twice the rate charged for the 15
- 16 same service within the corporate limits of the Town of
- Leakesville. 17
- The authority conferred by this act shall not be 18
- construed as an exemption from the provisions of Chapter 3, Title 19
- 77, Mississippi Code of 1972, as to the requirements of obtaining 2.0
- a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, the 21
- jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission to regulate rates or 22
- 23 any other provision of that law.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 24
- and after its passage. 25
