HOUSE BILL NO. 1869

- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE ABERDEEN-MONROE COUNTY HOSPITAL, WITH APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MONROE COUNTY, TO MAKE, ENTER INTO AND APPROVE A 3 CONTRACT FOR MANAGEMENT SERVICES OF THE RESIDENTIAL FACILITY OWNED 4 BY MONROE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AND OPERATED BY THE ABERDEEN-MONROE COUNTY HOSPITAL WITH A TERM OF TEN YEARS; AND FOR RELATED 5 6 7 PURPOSES.
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. For the purposes of this act, the following words 9 10 and phrases shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this
- section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Board" means the Board of Supervisors of Monroe 12 (a)
- County, Mississippi. 13
- "Board of trustees" means the Board of Trustees of 14 (b)
- 15 the Aberdeen-Monroe County Hospital.
- "County" means Monroe County, Mississippi. 16
- 17 "Hospital" means the Aberdeen-Monroe County

- "Pioneer" means Pioneer Health Services, Inc. 19
- SECTION 2. The Legislature finds that it is in the best 20
- interest of the persons living in the area served by the 21
- residential facility known as "Personal Place and Garden Suites 22
- 23 Assisted Living" within the county to have a private entity manage
- 24 such residential facility. The purpose of this act is to
- authorize the board of trustees, with the approval of the board, 25
- to make, enter into and approve a management services contract 26
- with Pioneer for the residential facility with a term of up to ten 27
- 28 (10) years.

- SECTION 3. The county and the hospital are vested with all 29 the powers necessary and requisite that are capable of being 30 authorized by the Legislature for the accomplishment of the 31 32 purposes of this act. No enumeration of powers in this act impair 33 or limit any general grant of power contained in this act or limit any grant of power or powers of the same class or classes as those 34 enumerated. The county and the hospital may both do all acts 35 necessary, proper or convenient in the exercise of the powers 36
- 38 **SECTION 4.** The hospital, acting by and through the board of trustees, with approval of the board, may make, enter into and approve a management services contract with Pioneer for the residential facility for a period of up to ten (10) years.

- section 5. This act shall be liberally construed for the purposes set out in the act, the powers in this act granted being additional cumulative and supplemental to any power granted to the county, the hospital, any municipality within the county or any community hospital within the county by any general law or any local and private act of the Legislature.
- SECTION 6. If any provision of this act is held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this act shall not be affected by that determination.
- 51 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 52 and after its passage.
