Dickerson, a native of Yazoo and Holmes 10 Counties, Mississippi, and a graduate of Durant High School in 1978, was a member of the United States Armed Forces, stationed at 11 the Pentagon and living in Springfield, Virginia; and 12 WHEREAS, Lt. Dickerson's higher education matriculation 13 resulted in receiving his associates degree from Holmes Community 14 College in 1980, and bachelor of science degree in economics, 15 graduating as the Distinguished Military Graduate in Reserve 16 17 Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) from Mississippi State University 18 in 1983; and WHEREAS, after graduation, Lt. Col. Dickerson was 19 commissioned as a second lieutenant in the United States Army 20 Field Artillery, where he earned the Army Air Assault and Airborne 21 badges; and 22 WHEREAS, devoted not only to protecting and serving the 23 United States, Lt. Col. Dickerson likewise devoted his time and 24 energy to his family, and for his untiring devotion was awarded 25 26 three Meritorious Service Medals, two Army Achievement Medals, the Berlin Army of Occupation Medal and numerous other awards; and 27
