- 8 Amend Section 153, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read
- 9 as follows:
- 10 "Section 153. The judges of the circuit and chancery courts
- 11 shall be elected by the people in a manner and at a time to be
- 12 provided by the Legislature and the judges shall hold their office
- 13 for a term of six (6) years."
- 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be
- 15 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at
- 16 an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday
- 17 of November 2002, as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution

- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
- 20 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
- 21 constitutional amendment will increase the terms of circuit court
- 22 judges from four to six years."
