- Amend the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 by creating a new 10
- section to read as follows: 11
- "SECTION . The flag of the State of Mississippi, as 12
- established by Chapter 37, Laws of 1894, is hereby reestablished 13

- particularly described as follows: The flag of the State of 15
- Mississippi shall have a width two-thirds (2/3) of its length, 16
