- BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF 9
- MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi 10
- 11 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- state: 12
- Amend Section 109, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read 13
- as follows: 14
- "Section 109. No public officer or member of the Legislature 15
- shall be interested, directly or indirectly, in any contract with 16
- the state, or any district, county, city, or town thereof, 17
- authorized by any law passed or order made by any board of which 18
- he may be or may have been a member, during the term for which he 19
- shall have been chosen, or within one (1) year after the 20
- expiration of such term. 21
- The provisions of this section shall not be construed to 22
- prohibit a tenant of a public housing authority with which the 23
- Department of Housing and Urban Development, or any successor 24
- 25 agency, has entered an annual contributions contract from serving
- on the governing body of the public housing authority." 26
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be 27
- 28 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at
- an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday 29

- 30 of November 2002, as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution
- 31 and by general law.
- 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
- 33 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
- 34 constitutional amendment provides that Section 109 of the
- 35 Constitution, prohibiting certain conflicts of interest among
- 36 public officials, shall not be construed to prohibit a tenant of a
- 37 public housing authority with which the Department of Housing and
- 38 Urban Development has entered an annual contributions contract
- 39 from serving on the governing body of the public housing
- 40 authority."
