- WHEREAS, Ted Wayne Hillman, lifelong Raleigh native, born
- 5 July 12, 1955, received his 12 years of formal education in the
- 6 Raleigh Public School System; and
- WHEREAS, before graduating from high school, Mr. Hillman
- 8 enlisted in the United States Army, at the age of 18, with a
- 9 desire to be assigned to the Military Police; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Hillman, upon the completion of basic training,
- 11 was sent to Germany before being reassigned as a recruiter for the
- 12 Jackson, Mississippi, area; and
- 13 WHEREAS, after serving as Raleigh's Chief of Police for 16
- 14 years, Mr. Hillman, in 1999, applied for the International Police
- 15 Mission through the United States State Department to assist in
- 16 the United Nations' peacekeeping missions around the world; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Mr. Hillman was accepted to undergo a two-week
- 18 training program in April 2000, and, upon successful completion,
- 19 was accepted to serve on a peacekeeping mission on the island of
- 20 East Timor, Indonesia; and
- 21 WHEREAS, upon deployment, Mr. Hillman was assigned to Dili,
- 22 East Timor's capital and largest city with a population of more
- 23 than 160,000 inhabitants, and was ordered to open a police
- 24 substation; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Mr. Hillman, after six months of service, was
- 26 promoted to Station Commander of the Dili substation, and was
- 27 given the duty of administering and overseeing the conduct and

- 28 duties of approximately 175 officers from 40 countries along with
- 29 the newly trained Timorese officers; and
- 30 WHEREAS, accounting for his first International Peacekeeping
- 31 Mission, Mr. Hillman's year of service to the United Nations
- 32 provided him a great learning experience and the opportunity to
- 33 meet different people from all walks of life; and
- 34 WHEREAS, Mr. Hillman has been faithfully supported in all of
- 35 his endeavors by his loving wife, Brenda Ivy Hillman; three
- 36 children, Shaina, Lucas and Jacob; sister, Rosalyn Glenn; and
- 37 brother, Boyd Nichols Hillman; and

- 39 Ted Wayne Hillman, who has dedicated many years of service to this
