HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 89

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MS.
2 GAYLE GREENE-AGUIRRE FOR BEING SELECTED AS INSTRUCTOR OF THE YEAR
3 AT THE PERKINSTON CAMPUS OF THE MISSISSIPPI GULF COAST COMMUNITY
4 COLLEGE.

5 WHEREAS, Ms. Gayle Greene-Aguirre, a resident of Gulfport,
6 Mississippi, has been selected as Instructor of the Year at the
7 Perkinston Campus of the Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College
8 in recognition of her distinguished service to the college; and

9 WHEREAS, the award was established by the Alumni Association
10 of the Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College to honor
11 instructors at the college, and the recipient of the award is
12 chosen from nominations submitted by students, faculty and
13 administrators, on the basis of their teaching excellence, college
14 service, community service and professional development; and

15 WHEREAS, Ms. Greene-Aguirre, a social studies instructor, has
16 been employed at the Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College for
17 the past five years and has taught for the past 18 years and was
18 chosen in 2001 as the Mississippi Humanities Council Teacher of
19 the Year and the Bennie Warren Outstanding Phi Theta Kappa Advisor
20 for the Mississippi-Louisiana region; and

21 WHEREAS, Ms. Greene-Aguirre received her B.A. from the
22 University of Connecticut, her M.A. from the University of North
23 Texas, and is completing extensive graduate work at the University
24 of Southern Mississippi and William Carey College; and

25 WHEREAS, serving as a sponsor for Phi Theta Kappa, Gamma Nu
26 Chapter, Ms. Greene-Aguirre brought the chapter from a Level 3
27 rating to a Level 5, and has served as committee chair for the
28 Perk Festival of Lights, served on the vice president's committee



29 and judicial board, served as judge for the State History Fair and
30 the College Quiz Bowl Competition; and

31 WHEREAS, a retired lieutenant colonel of the Women's Army
32 Corps as of 1996, Ms. Greene-Aguirre has published numerous
33 articles and has given presentations throughout the United States;

35 WHEREAS, Ms. Greene-Aguirre is a member of the Mississippi
36 Professional Educators, the Mississippi Foreign Language
37 Association, the Alabama-Mississippi Association for Teachers of
38 English as a Second Language, the American Association of
39 University Women and the National Council for History Education;

41 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
42 and commend such outstanding teachers as Ms. Gayle Greene-Aguirre,
43 who has dedicated her career to teaching the young people of this
44 state:

46 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
47 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Ms. Gayle
