HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 97

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING WILL
2 OVERSTREET ON HIS OUTSTANDING FOOTBALL PLAY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF
3 TENNESSEE.

4 WHEREAS, in 1998, Will Overstreet, a native of Jackson,
5 Mississippi, and graduate of Jackson Preparatory School, began his
6 collegiate football career at the University of Tennessee, by
7 establishing himself as a solid player on the Volunteer's
8 defensive line; and

9 WHEREAS, through hard work and determination, Will earned the
10 respect of his coaches and gained a starting position in 1999,
11 where he continued his dominance over offensive lines throughout
12 the Southeastern Conference; and

13 WHEREAS, in his junior season, Will was named to the
14 All-Southeastern Conference Team, an honor which sealed his
15 position as one of the top defensive linemen in the Southeastern
16 Conference as well as the nation; and

17 WHEREAS, despite a knee injury during the Louisiana State
18 University game in 2001, Will fought to overcome adversity and
19 managed to play the remainder of the season in outstanding
20 fashion, earning him a spot for the second year in a row on the
21 All-Southeastern Conference Team; and

22 WHEREAS, proven to be competitive in the classroom as well as
23 on the field, Will was named to the Academic All-Southeastern
24 Conference Team three straight years and also earned a spot on the
25 Verizon All-Academic District IV Team and in 2001, on the Verizon
26 Academic All-American Team; and



27 WHEREAS, although playing across state lines, Will Overstreet
28 brings much pride to his native state and will always be
29 considered as one of Mississippi's finest; and

30 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
31 unique and talented individuals, such as Will Overstreet, whose
32 work ethic and devotion serves as an outstanding model for all
33 Mississippians:

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
35 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
36 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate William
37 Sparkman Overstreet on his successful football career at the
38 University of Tennessee and extend to him our heartiest wishes for
39 continued success in all his future endeavors.
