HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 109

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING WEBB BOZEMAN ON BEING
2 SELECTED A TOP 25 FINALIST FOR THE NATIONAL OUTSTANDING YOUNG
3 FARMERS AWARDS.

4 WHEREAS, Webb Bozeman, a resident of Flora, Mississippi, was
5 recently named as one of the nation's top 25 finalists for the
6 National Outstanding Young Farmers Awards; and

7 WHEREAS, for his selection, Mr. Bozeman was flown to Grand
8 Rapids, Michigan, with all expenses paid by the United States
9 Junior Chamber of Commerce, for an awards ceremony naming the
10 nation's top four outstanding young farmers; and

11 WHEREAS, administering the Outstanding Young Farmers program
12 since 1954, the United States Junior Chamber of Commerce seeks to
13 improve conditions for the farmer and better urban-rural relations
14 through a keener understanding of the problems facing agriculture;

16 WHEREAS, after earning a degree in agricultural economics
17 from Mississippi State University, Mr. Bozeman, with the aid of
18 his wife, became an independent farmer in 1996 when his father
19 retired with 40 years' experience in the farming industry; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Bozeman has experienced substantial growth and
21 success since making his start in farming, now planting 1800 acres
22 and having experienced an increase in all crop yields; and

23 WHEREAS, having memberships in the Mississippi Farm Bureau
24 Federation, County Co-op, County ASCS Office, County Forestry
25 Association and North American Limousine Association, Mr. Bozeman
26 shares the distinguished honor of being in the nation's top 25
27 finalists for the National Outstanding Young Farmers Awards with



28 his family and all those who have contributed to his success as a
29 farmer; and

30 WHEREAS, Mr. Bozeman is faithfully supported in his farming
31 operation by his wife, Frances, and together they have instilled
32 in their daughters, Karley and Danielle, an appreciation for the
33 importance of the agricultural industry within our society; and

34 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
35 and commend excellence in outstanding Mississippians such as Mr.
36 Bozeman, whose remarkable accomplishments in the field of
37 agriculture have brought great pride and national recognition to
