## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 118

- 1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING JUDGE MICHAEL P. MILLS ON 2 HIS APPOINTMENT AS UNITED STATES DISTRICT JUDGE FOR THE NORTHERN
- 3 DISTRICT OF MISSISSIPPI.
- WHEREAS, on September 4, 2001, President George W. Bush
- 5 nominated Michael P. Mills to be United States District Judge for
- 6 the Northern District of Mississippi; on October 11, 2001, Judge
- 7 Mills was confirmed by the United States Senate and on October 16,
- 8 2001, he received his commission; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mike Mills served as a Mississippi Supreme Court
- 10 Justice from 1995 to 2001 and as a member of the Mississippi House
- 11 of Representatives from 1984 to 1995; and
- 12 WHEREAS, during his tenure as a member of the Mississippi
- 13 House of Representatives, Mike Mills served as Chairman of the
- 14 Judiciary "A" and Judiciary En Banc Committees, authoring numerous
- 15 judicial improvements including the White Collar Crime Act, the
- 16 Statewide Grand Jury Act and the 1994 Court Reform Act which
- 17 created the Intermediate Court of Appeals and update circuit and
- 18 chancery court procedures; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Judge Mills graduated from Itawamba Agricultural
- 20 High School in 1974, received his A.A. degree from Itawamba
- 21 Community College in 1976, received his B.A. degree from the
- 22 University of Mississippi in 1978, received his J.D. degree from
- 23 the University of Mississippi School of Law in 1980 and received
- 24 his L.L.M. degree from the University of Virginia School of Law in
- 25 2001; and



- 26 WHEREAS, before becoming a judge, he enjoyed a successful
- 27 career as a practicing attorney in Monroe and Itawamba Counties;
- 28 and
- 29 WHEREAS, in addition to a vast knowledge of the law, Judge
- 30 Mills is an ardent enthusiast of the Blues, studying and lecturing
- 31 on this art form which has its roots in his beloved Mississippi
- 32 and learning to play the songs of his favorite artists; and
- 33 WHEREAS, Judge Mills has been published in several legal
- 34 journals and his short story "There's Pow'r in the Blood" received
- 35 an award in the 2001 Tallahatchie Riverfest William Faulkner
- 36 Writing Competition; and
- 37 WHEREAS, Judge Mills is a Fellow of the Mississippi Bar
- 38 Foundation and a member of the American Bar Association and he is
- 39 a former commissioner on the National Conference of Commissioners
- 40 on Uniform State Laws; and
- WHEREAS, Judge Mills is married to the former Mona Robinson
- 42 and they are the proud parents of Alysson, Chip, Rebekah and Penn;

- WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Legislature to recognize and
- 45 commend excellence, especially when evidenced by the exemplary
- 46 accomplishments of an outstanding jurist such as Judge Michael P.
