- 12 impoverished climate of Detroit's ghetto, living a turbulent and

- 26 Phase-Out Treaty of the Panama Canal Zone, and in 1980, he was

- 30 several Fortune 500 companies such as IBM, Baxter Corporation, US
- 31 West, GMC, GTE and Intuit; has worked extensively with industries
