1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MRS. CAROLYN KING BRAMLETT UPON BEING
2 INDUCTED INTO THE MISSISSIPPI HALL OF MASTER TEACHERS.

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Carolyn King Bramlett, a gifted teacher at
4 Oxford Elementary School, was inducted into the 2001-2002
5 Mississippi Hall of Master Teachers; and

7 Mississippi University for Women (MUW), Mrs. Bramlett, along with
8 two other North-Mississippi area teachers, was honored for her
9 contributions to education; and

10 WHEREAS, Mrs. Bramlett, a teacher since 1972, received both
11 her bachelor of arts degree in education and her master of
12 education degree from the University of Mississippi; and

13 WHEREAS, certified as a learning styles instructor, Mrs.
14 Bramlett was named the Oxford Elementary School Teacher of the
15 Year and Oxford School District Teacher of the Year for 2000-2001;

17 WHEREAS, named a finalist for the 2000 Mississippi Hall of
18 Master Teachers, Mrs. Bramlett, a 30-year veteran teacher,
19 epitomizes the highest standards of educator professionalism; and

20 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives of
21 the State of Mississippi to commend such outstanding
22 Mississippians as Mrs. Bramlett, whose positive influence upon her
23 students and whose contributions to the educational arena are
