A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MRS. ANNIE M. LYNCH ON BEING NAMED A 1 STATEWIDE MISSISSIPPI AGELESS HERO. 2 3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Annie M. Lynch, resident of Florence, 4 Mississippi, and the oldest of six children, learned at an early age how to be a helpmate; and 5 WHEREAS, desiring to serve others, Mrs. Lynch was inspired by 6 7 mission trips to Mexico to develop a way to assist the needy in her own backyard; and 8 WHEREAS, in August 1998, Mrs. Lynch took \$168.00 collected 9 from children at her church, \$200.00 donated by her daughter and 10 her own social security check and opened the County Line Food 11 Pantry; and 12 WHEREAS, now 68 years old, Mrs. Lynch was chosen from a pool 13 of more than 200 nominees submitted to the Ageless Heroes program 14 15 sponsored by Blue Cross & Blue Shield, which honors those persons age 65 and over who have made significant contributions to the 16 State of Mississippi and their communities; and 17 WHEREAS, in addition to honoring those persons named Ageless 18 Heroes, Blue Cross & Blue Shield also donates \$1,000.00 to each 19 hero's favorite charity; and 20 WHEREAS, Mrs. Lynch and her husband, Thomas, drive to Jackson 21 on a weekly basis to purchase 3,500 to 5,000 pounds of food for 22 the nonprofit pantry, which is divided by volunteers and 23 distributed to the residents in southwest Rankin County and 24 25 northwest Simpson County; and WHEREAS, with the help of donations from friends and churches 26 and lots of volunteer labor, Mrs. Lynch, through the 24-hour 27 35 H. R. No. N1/2 28 County Line Food Pantry, provides food for 240 family units and 29 provides access to important information on government programs, 30 as well as transportation for interested persons to sign up for 31 these government programs; and

32 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives of 33 the State of Mississippi to recognize and pay special tribute to 34 remarkable citizens such as Mrs. Annie M. Lynch, whose 35 outstanding, dedicated public service is an inspiration to all 36 Mississippians, young and old alike:
