HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 56

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING WILLIAM PERKINS, HADEN GRAGSON AND
2 WILLIAM CRUMP IV UPON EARNING EAGLE SCOUT HONORS.

3 WHEREAS, William Perkins, Haden Gragson and William Crump IV,
4 all of Boy Scouts of America (BSA) Troop 200 in Greenwood,
5 Mississippi, attained the rank of Eagle Scout on February 27,
6 2002; and

7 WHEREAS, after earning at least 21 merit badges and
8 completing individual community service projects, Perkins, Gragson
9 and Crump made the pledge to live under the four characteristics
10 of an Eagle Scout: to live with honor, to be loyal, to be
11 courageous and to serve the community, nation and world daily; and

12 WHEREAS, Perkins, an 18-year-old senior at Pillow Academy,
13 built a steel sign at Pillow honoring the patrons of the school
14 for his Eagle Scout project; and

15 WHEREAS, Gragson, also an 18-year-old Pillow Academy senior,
16 landscaped a flower bed outside the locker room at Pillow for his
17 project; and

18 WHEREAS, 18-year-old Crump, a freshman at Delta State
19 University, for his Eagle Scout project, crafted a guide to help
20 locate names at the Veterans Memorial located on Claiborne Avenue
21 in Greenwood; and

22 WHEREAS, each of these young men have prided themselves in
23 exhibiting great dedication to fulfilling the duties and
24 requirements of the BSA, and it is because of their diligence and
25 desire to serve the community, nation and world that they have
26 received the highest rank obtainable by a Boy Scout; and



27 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives of
28 the State of Mississippi to recognize and commend excellence,
29 especially when evidenced by the youth of our state, who are its
30 future:

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
32 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby
33 commend and congratulate William Perkins, Haden Gragson and
34 William Crump IV on receiving the rank of Eagle Scout and express
