HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 66

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MR. RICHARD GREENE FOR 25 YEARS OF

8 Mississippi in 1974 and served as Director of the Oktibbeha County
9 Library System in Starkville; and

10 WHEREAS, in 1976, Mr. Greene came to the Mid-Mississippi
11 Regional Library System in Kosciusko, where he serves as the
12 director; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Greene attended Syracuse University earning his
14 bachelor's and master's degree in library science and has also
15 studied at Rochester Institute of Technology and Mississippi State
16 University; and

17 WHEREAS, during his tenure as Director of the MMRLS, Mr.
18 Greene has helped guide the completion of a new library building
19 in Lexington, an addition and renovation at West, renovation at
20 Pickens and additions in Durant; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Greene has been an active member of community
22 and professional organizations including former President of the
23 Mississippi Library Association, chairman of various committees
24 for the association such as the legislative committee, long-range
25 planning committee and public library section committee; and



26 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
27 recognize and commend outstanding service of Mississippians such
28 as Mr. Greene:
