JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 201

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION TO REDISTRIBUTE THE MISSISSIPPI STATE
2 SENATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
4 MISSISSIPPI, That the number of Senators shall be fifty-two (52)
5 and shall be elected from fifty-two (52) districts, composed as
6 follows:

476 of the Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment
477 shall file with the Secretary of State the Split Precinct Block
478 List developed in conjunction with the plan contained in this
479 joint resolution that details the portions of the partial or split
480 precincts that are contained within a district by census tract and
481 block number, and such document duly filed with the Secretary of



482 State is hereby incorporated into and shall be construed to be an
483 integral part of this joint resolution.

484 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the boundaries of the senatorial
485 districts described above shall be:

486 (a) The boundaries of the counties listed above as such
487 boundaries existed as of January 1, 2002.

488 (b) The boundaries of the precincts listed above as
489 such boundaries are contained in Census 2000 redistricting maps
490 (Public Law 94-171) Tiger line file; and

491 (c) The boundaries of the census tracts and blocks
492 listed above as such boundaries are contained in Census 2000
493 redistricting maps (Public Law 94-171) Tiger line file.

494 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall be
495 liberally construed to effectuate the purposes thereof and to
496 redistrict the Senate of this state in compliance with
497 constitutional requirements.

498 It is intended that this resolution and the districts
499 described herein completely encompass all the area within the
500 state. It is also intended that such districts contain all the
501 inhabitants in this state. It is further intended that the
502 redistricting provided for in this resolution result in the
503 creation of districts which are substantially equal in population.
504 It is also intended that no district shall include any of the area
505 included within the description of any other district.

506 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the redistricting of
507 representative districts and senate districts shall be deemed to
508 be separate from each other. The invalidity of the districts of
509 one (1) house shall not affect or require the redistricting of the
510 other house when the districts of the other house have been found
511 to be valid by a court of competent jurisdiction.

512 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the districts described in
513 this resolution do not carry out the purposes thereof, because of
514 unintentional omissions; duplications; overlapping areas;



515 erroneous nomenclature; lack of adequate maps or descriptions of
516 political subdivisions, wards or other divisions thereof, or of
517 their boundary lines, then the Secretary of State, at the request
518 of the Senate Elections Committee shall, by order, correct such
519 omissions, overlaps, erroneous nomenclature or other defects in
520 the description of districts so as to accomplish the purposes and
521 objectives of this resolution.

522 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That in promulgating such orders, the
523 Secretary of State, in addition to achieving equality in the
524 population of districts and insuring that all areas of the state
525 are completely and accurately encompassed in such districts, shall
526 be guided by the following standards:

527 (a) Gaps in the description of any district shall be
528 completed in a manner which results in a total description of that
529 district in a manner which is consonant with the description of
530 adjacent districts and results in complete contiguity of
531 districts;

532 (b) Areas of the state included within the descriptions
533 of more than one (1) district shall be allocated to the district
534 having the lowest population;

535 (c) Areas of the state not included within the
536 descriptions of any district shall be allocated to the adjacent
537 district having the lowest population;

538 (d) In the event that the area subject to corrected
539 description or allocation as provided in paragraphs (a), (b) and
540 (c) of this clause is of such size or contains such population
541 that its inclusion as a unit in any district would result in
542 substantial disparity in the size, shape or population of such
543 district, then the Secretary of State may allocate portions of
544 such area to two (2) or more districts; and

545 (e) In any allocation of area or correction of
546 descriptions made pursuant to this resolution, the Secretary of
547 State shall, consistent with the foregoing standards, preserve the



548 contiguity and compactness of districts and avoid the unnecessary
549 division of political subdivisions.

550 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of such orders shall be
551 filed by the Secretary of State in his own office and in the
552 offices of the affected commissioners of election and registrars.
553 The Secretary of State may adopt reasonable rules regulating the
554 procedure for applications for orders under this resolution in the
555 manner of serving and filing any notice or copy of orders relating
556 thereto. Upon the filing of such an order, the description of any
557 affected district shall be deemed to have been corrected in the
558 manner provided in such order to the full extent as if such
559 correction had been contained in the original description set
560 forth in this resolution.

561 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Standing Joint Legislative
562 Committee on Reapportionment is directed to provide all
563 information necessary to assist the counties in identifying the
564 boundaries of the districts described in this resolution.

565 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the redistricting contained in
566 this resolution shall supercede any prior redistricting, and any
567 prior redistricting shall be null and void upon the date this
568 resolution is effectuated pursuant to the provisions of Section 5
569 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965 or pursuant to a final decision
570 by any court of competent jurisdiction, whichever shall first
571 occur.

572 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall be placed
573 in the editor's notes that follow Section 5-1-3, Mississippi Code
574 of 1972.

575 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if any paragraph, sentence,
576 clause, phrase of any part of this resolution is declared to be
577 unconstitutional or void or if for any reason is declared to be
578 invalid or of no effect, the remaining paragraphs, sentences,
579 clauses, phrases or parts thereof shall be in no manner affected
580 thereby but shall remain in full force and effect.



581 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Senate
582 Elections Committee, with the assistance of counsel employed by
583 the Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment, is
584 hereby directed to submit this resolution, immediately upon its
585 adoption by both houses of the Legislature, to the Attorney
586 General of the United States or to the United States District
587 Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
588 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
589 extended.

590 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall take
591 effect and be in force from and after the date it is finally
592 effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as
593 amended and extended.
