COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2026

1 AN ACT TO CREATE A SPECIAL "CHOOSE LIFE" MOTOR VEHICLE 2 LICENSE TAG; TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION OF THE FEE CHARGED FOR SUCH 3 TAG SHALL BE DISBURSED TO THE CHOOSE LIFE ADVISORY COMMITTEE; TO 4 PRESCRIBE THE MANNER IN WHICH FUNDS DERIVED FROM SUCH FEE MAY BE 5 SPENT BY THE CHOOSE LIFE ADVISORY COMMITTEE; AND FOR RELATED 6 PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 8 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 9 10 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 11 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 12 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (4) of this 13 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor 14 vehicle registered in his name, which shall be produced in such 15 color and design as the State Tax Commission, with the advice of 16 the Choose Life Advisory Committee, may prescribe. The words 17 "Choose Life" shall be centered at the bottom of the license taq. 18 The State Tax Commission shall prescribe such letters or numbers, 19 or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag. 20

(2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 21 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 22 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 23 additional fee imposed under subsection (4) of this section, less 24 Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be retained by the tax collector, shall be 25 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as 26 27 prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county 28

Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 30 (3) 31 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 32 of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each distinctive license tag 33 34 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 35 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 36 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 37 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 38 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 39 40 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 41 42 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax collector. 43

(4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
the State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected
under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute
such collections as follows:

49 (a) Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of each additional fee
50 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
51 section shall be disbursed to the Choose Life Advisory Committee
52 to be used as provided for in subsection (5) of this section.

(b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

57 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
58 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
59 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
60 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
61 reconstruction of highways.

Committee under this section shall be used by such committee as
follows:

(i) Seventy percent (70%) shall be used to provide
for the material needs of pregnant women who are committed to
placing their children for adoption, including clothing, housing,
medical care, food, utilities and transportation;

69 (ii) The remaining funds may only be used for70 adoption, counseling, training or advertising.

(b) Funds disbursed to the Choose Life Advisory Committee under this section shall not be used for administrative expenses, legal expenses, capital expenditures, attempting to influence any legislation or any political campaign on behalf or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

76 (6) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 77 The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 78 this section. 79 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) month 80 and year license decals for each distinctive license tag issued 81 under this section, which will expire the same month and year as 82 83 the license tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license (7) 84 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 85 86 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 87 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 88 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 89 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 90 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 91 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 92 93 distinctive license tags issued under this section.
