## SENATE BILL NO. 2044

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-13-131, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REQUIRE CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION INSTRUCTION IN HEALTH 2
- 3 CLASSES IN GRADES 9 THROUGH 12; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 37-13-131, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- amended as follows: 6
- 37-13-131. (1) The State Department of Education is 7
- 8 designated as the state agency responsible for the administration
- and supervision of the Comprehensive School Health Education 9
- Program as an educational curriculum in the State of Mississippi. 10
- It is the intent of the Legislature that all funds made available 11
- to the State Department of Education for the purpose of 12
- 13 comprehensive school health education shall be administered by the
- State Department of Education. 14
- (2) Pursuant to the provisions of subsection (1) of this 15
- section, the State Department of Education is authorized to 16
- establish an Office of Comprehensive School Health Education 17
- within the framework of the State Department of Education for the 18
- purpose of developing standards, procedures and criteria for the 19
- 20 administration and supervision of a statewide program of health
- 21 education in Kindergarten through Grade 12. The State Department
- of Education, through the Office of Comprehensive School Health 22
- Education, shall assume the further responsibility for promoting a 23
- statewide effort designed to prepare local school faculties and 24
- staffs to incorporate the comprehensive health education concept 25
- 26 into their local educational programs.

- 27 (3) The Mississippi Department of Health, in conjunction
- 28 with the Office of Student Development-Branch of Health-Related
- 29 Services of the State Department of Education, shall develop a
- 30 long-range strategic plan for a Comprehensive School Health
- 31 Education Program in Grades K through 12. The Comprehensive
- 32 School Health Education Program shall encompass four (4)
- 33 interdependent components: (a) health education; (b) health
- 34 service; (c) physical education and fitness; and (d) a healthful
- 35 school environment. These curriculum components shall be designed
- 36 to develop decision-making competencies related to health and
- 37 health behavior. Such curriculum components are intended to
- 38 motivate health maintenance and promote wellness, not only to
- 39 prevent disease or disability. The Mississippi Department of
- 40 Health, in conjunction with the Office of Student
- 41 Development-Branch of Health-Related Services of the Department of
- 42 Education, shall develop the strategic plan and make a report
- 43 thereon to the Governor and the Legislature on or before January
- 44 1, 1995.
- 45 (4) The following words shall have the meaning ascribed
- herein unless the context clearly states otherwise:
- 47 <u>"Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)" shall pertain to a procedure</u>
- 48 employed after cardiac arrest in which cardiac massage and
- 49 mouth-to-mouth resuscitation are used to restore rhythm and
- 50 breathing. All state accredited health classes in Grades 9
- 51 through 12 shall teach Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) to each
- 52 student.
- 53 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 54 and after July 1, 2002.
