SENATE BILL NO. 2064

AN ACT MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO KNOWINGLY SELL,

BARTER, EXCHANGE, DELIVER OR GIVE AWAY A BIDI CIGARETTE TO ANOTHER 2 PERSON; TO DEFINE THE TERM "BIDI CIGARETTE"; AND FOR RELATED 3 4 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. No person shall knowingly sell, barter, exchange, 6 deliver or give away a bidi cigarette to another person, nor shall 7 a person cause or permit or procure a bidi cigarette to be sold, 8 9 bartered, exchanged, delivered or given away to another person. Any person who knowingly violates or knowingly causes the 10 violation of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor for 11 which the offender may be fined an amount as follows: 12 (a) For a first offense, not less than One Hundred 13 Dollars (\$100.00) and not more than Five Hundred Dollars 14 15 (\$500.00);For a second offense within a two-year period, not 16 (b) 17 less than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) and not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00); 18 19 (C) For a third or subsequent offense within a two-year period, not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and not more 20 21 than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). For purposes of this section, the term "bidi cigarette" means 22 a product that contains tobacco that is wrapped in temburni leaf 23 (diospyros melanoxylon) or tendu leaf (diospyros exculpra) or that 24 is wrapped in another material identified by rules of the State 25 Department of Health that is similar in appearance or 26 characteristics to the temburni or tendu leaf. 27
