BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section

8 37-43-24, Mississippi Code of 1972:

<u>37-43-24.</u> (1) This section shall be referred to and may be
cited as the <u>"Brooks Wall/Colton Ladner Timely Acquisition of</u>
<u>Braille and Large Print Textbooks Act of 2002."</u>

The State Department of Education is hereby authorized 12 (2)13 and directed to place textbook procurement orders for visually 14 impaired and hearing impaired students in the schools of this state prior to the beginning of the fiscal year for which the 15 expenditure for such order has been authorized by the Legislature, 16 and in no event after June 1 of each year. The department shall 17 insure that the appropriate procedures for textbook procurement 18 19 are followed according to state law and board policy as described in the Textbook Administration handbook. 20

21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 22 and after its passage.
