- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or
- 7 corporation to broadcast in this state a television advertisement
- 8 at a volume of higher decibel levels than the level of the
- 9 television program preceding the advertisement. Any person, firm
- 10 or corporation that violates the provisions of this section shall
- 11 upon conviction be fined not more than Five Thousand Dollars
- 12 (\$5,000.00) or imprisoned in the county jail not more than six (6)
- 13 months, or both fine and imprisonment.

- 15 and after July 1, 2002.
