- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. A volunteer fire fighter registered with the
- State of Mississippi or a political subdivision thereof shall be 8
- 9 authorized to direct, control or regulate traffic while actually
- engaged in the performance of his duties if in the absence of or 10
- at the direction of a law enforcement authority. 11
- SECTION 2. Section 63-3-203, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 12

- 14 63-3-203. No person shall willfully fail or refuse to comply
- with any lawful order or direction of any police officer or 15
